After finishing up our time on outreach, all the teams that were part of the school I was in came back to Kona to debrief our outreaches and share the incredible testimonies of the work God was doing in all the other nations we were in. We also had some more classes preparing for coming home and what to look for next. In our debrief, we had multiple questions to get us thinking about what our highlights were and what we learnt, etc.

My highlight and ties into what I learnt as well was just how it was such an intentional time to fall in love with Jesus. As I mentioned earlier in the year, I was really brought into and found my secret place and in that space I was able to learn so much about the character of Jesus and learn to hear His voice so clearly!! In that secret place, my love for the word grew so much to where I was able to read cover to cover, front to back, and while we were in Samoa, in the downtime that we had, I read through the New Testament in just over a week.
